The first is Oktoberfest A 2-week festival held each year in Munich, Germany It usually includes traditional german food and in some occasions beer Let's get it straight It doesn't matter how you spell it (Octoberfest or Oktoberfest) If you are advertising an Ocktoerfest/Octoberfest Don't have us show up and there's no Hendl (chicken), Schweinsbraten (roast pork), Haxn (knuckle of pork), Steckerlfisch (grilled fish on a stick), Würstel (sausages) along with Brezel (Pretzel)), Knödeln (potato or bread dumplings), Käsespätzle (cheese noodles), Reiberdatschi (potato pancakes), Sauerkraut or Blaukraut (red cabbage) along with such Bavarian delicacies as Obatzda (a fatty, spiced cheese-butter concoction) and/ or Weisswurst (a white sausage). if you're not having these things Call it what it is: FALL FESTIVAL, PUMPKIN FEST, OCTOBER FESTIVAL The second is Halloween It's Halloween, not Mardi Gras IT IS NOT MARDI GRAS TIME!! Mardi Gras" (French for Fat Tuesday) is the day before Ash Wednesday. Mardi Gras is the final day of Carnival, the three day period preceding the beginning of Lent, the Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday immediately before Ash Wednesday. The entire three day period has come to be known in many areas as Mardi Gras This usually occurs in late February or early March.
