

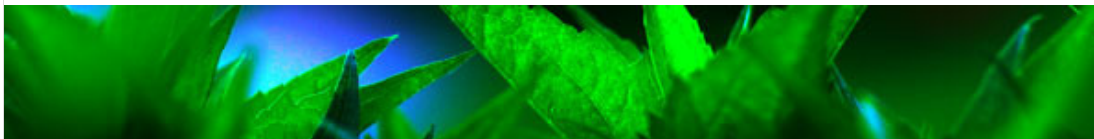

**"ART'S A BALL" CREATIVE
 FUND RAISER AT THE MAC**

Since 2002 the Middletown Township Cultural and Arts Council has organized a
 unique Community Arts Project that invites the public to construct and decorate
 an object that represents a special annual theme.

This year's theme is "Art's A Ball" and the participants will decorate,
 dress, and/or paint a spherical shape, i.e. a ball. Participants sponsor
 a ball, decorate it, turn it in at the Middletown Arts Center, and watch
 as the gallery fills with colorful one-of-a-kind creations.

You can sponsor a ball, pick it up at the MAC and decorate it yourself, or
 you can sponsor a ball and let a professional artist at the MAC do it for you.

There will be prizes for the top entries in each class and the
 exhibit will be on display June 17 to July 1.

This is a popular event because it not only allows those with creative
 skills to display their artistic talents, but it also helps to raise funds so
 that the MAC's educational programming can continue to be available f
 or the community.

The three sponsorship categories are: Individual/Non-Profit Sponsor @ \$25;
 Small Business Sponsor @ \$100; and Corporate Sponsor @ \$250.

The last two categories enable business and corporate sponsors to
 decorate with company logos and/or to suggest the products they sell
 The deadline for the sponsorship of professionally decorated balls is May 1,
 and the deadline for all other entries is June 10, 2009.

The Artists' reception, open to the public, will be on June 20.
