SEA BRIGHT RESIDENTS

**Starting today residents of Sea Bright clobbered by Hurricane Sandy will be allowed access in to town to inspect and retrieve personal belongings.
Today that access is limited to anyone who resides NORTH of the Rumson Bridge.
You may enter the Borough only with an escort to inspect your home and retrieve personal items on between the hours of 9:00am until 3:30 pm.
Tomorrow, Tuesday, November 6th, residents SOUTH of the Rumson Bridge may enter the Borough to inspect their homes and retrieve personal items. Again only between the hours of 9:00 am until 3:30 pm with escort.
NO VEHICLES WILL BE PERMITTED. A station has been set up at the foot of the Rumson bridge where residents will sign in and be transported to their homes. You must bring proof of residence, and PLEASE, do not bring any children or animals.
Sea Bright officials ask for your patience in waiting your turn as they go through this process.**
